MD Exams No Longer Required Below \$10 Million Face Amounts*

Good News! Prudential has recently revised its age and amount requirements for Medical Doctor examinations. Effectively immediately, we will now only be requiring MD Exams for the following age ranges and face amounts:

Age	MD Exams Are Required at*:
0-70	\$10,000,000 and Above
71 & over	\$2,500,000 and Above

For cases under those face amounts, Paramedical exams are acceptable.

These changes make scheduling of exams easier for GA's, brokers and their clients and result in fewer cases requiring a medical doctor examination. After all, why make your clients go to an MD when they don't have to?
